Johnson's performance is based on the oral histories collected in his 2nd book, *Sweet Tea: Black Gay Men of the South -- An Oral History*.

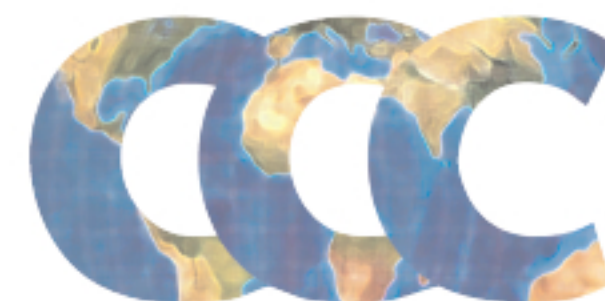
