Foreclosed families demand: **STOP** **evicting, Freddie Mac!!!** **take the rent or sell it back!**

Freddie Mac is willing to sell at true value to investors and Wall St. firms.
But **what about working people** who are offering a fair price to **stay in their own homes???**

Ramón Suero and his wife and 3 young children have lived in their home since 2005. When **they got behind on their underwater mortgage** due to job loss and caring for an ill parent, they applied for help, but **the bank wouldn't work out a fair modification** based on the real property value. Their condo was **foreclosed and turned over to Freddie Mac, who refused the family's request for a rental agreement.**

The Sueros got financing to buy back their home at current value and made 3 offers (for *more* than the 2 upstairs condos sold for recently) **but Freddie Mac wouldn't negotiate.** Instead, this government-run, publicly-financed bank spent thousands of dollars on legal fees to **evict the Suero family.** They have a **court order to leave Friday, Feb 1, 2013.** But the Sueros are **bravely taking a stand and fighting back** against Freddie Mac's foreclosure eviction policy. They have an important hearing on their case Jan 31.
