

# PROTEST RACIST LAYOFFS IN UNIVERSITY FINANCIAL SERVICES! TUES 4/23, 5 PM, HOLYOKE CTR (1350 MASS AVE)



Darlene and Sarah were laid off from their jobs at Harvard's University Financial Services, supposedly for "not meeting productivity standards." According to management's own statistics, both women, who are African American, actually did more work than white workers in the unit, all of whom are still employed at Harvard. For months management pressured, bullied and harassed UFS staff, threatening them with the loss of their jobs. Finally Darlene and Sarah were terminated, along with another worker of color (who also outperformed Caucasian colleagues). Please help us send the message that we will not tolerate this sickening injustice. **REINSTATE THE UFS WORKERS! NO TO DISCRIMINATORY LAYOFFS!** This is the third picket Darlene and Sarah's supporters have held since January, and our campaign will continue until we get justice.
