## Ashley Sanders a Move to Amend National Spokesperson



## "Organizing to End Corporate Rule & Get Money Out of Politics"

Ashley Sanders, a Move to Amend national spokesperson is available to speak to your campus/group to build connections, inspire activism, and reveal the origins of corporate power in America. Move to Amend is a non-partisan coalition of over 300,000 individuals and organizations whose goal it is to amend the US Constitution to end corporate rule and get money out of politics.

Ashley Sanders' presentation "Organizing to End Corporate Rule & Get Money Out of Politics" outlines the history of the American Constitution as it pertains to Corporate Personhood and illegitimate but legal corporate constitutional rights. It will be followed by a facilitated discussion session and Q&A. Sanders aims to help local folks understand how they can work to abolish corporate personhood and establish a government truly of, by, and for the people.

Ashley Sanders is a long-time organizer from Utah working to connect the dots between corporate power and the social justice issues of our day. She got her start as a national spokesperson working to push third parties into the national debate. She has worked as the national volunteer coordinator for High Road for Human Rights, served on the steering committee of Democracy Unlimited, coordinated campaigns to stop development in the Redwoods, and participated in campaigns for alternative currencies, indigenous rights and food sovereignty. Ashley is a co-founder of the national Move to Amend coalition, she's toured the country for Move to Amend's Stampede project to rally and organize local groups. She was a principal organizer of Occupy DC-Freedom Plaza and started the local Move to Amend Salt Lake affiliate. She currently works for the climate justice group, Peaceful Uprising, to fight tar sands mining in Utah and serves on the Move to Amend National Leadership Team as their National Youth Spokesperson.
