Hear Assata speak from Cuba, about her life in exile, and before. As you know, Assata has been placed on the f.b.i.'s "terrorist" hit list, with \$2 million dollars Dead or Alive. Some of us did not think that governments put bounty or contracts on citizens' lives. Some of us thought that contract killings were something that organized crime and gangsters did.

Join us on November 2 for a discussion about the definition of what is a terrorist? This day of awareness hopes to raise consciousness about the issue, and put pressure on the government to take her name off the terrorist list. Over the next year we will be lobbying embassies at the UN to make a formal request next November 2, 2014 to have her name removed along with others from the list.

DIRECTIONS: THE CENTER FOR THE ARTS AT THE ARMORY is located between Davis Square and Union Square. Arts at the Armory is approximately a 15-minute walk from Davis Square, which is on the MBTA Red Line. You can also find us by using either the MBTA RT 88 and RT 90 bus that can be caught either at Lechmere (Green Line) or Davis Square (Red Line). Get off at the Highland Avenue and Lowell Street stop. You can also get to us from Sullivan Square (Orange Line) by using the MBTA RT 90 bus. Get off at the Highland Avenue and Benton Road stop.
